

Slug magazine options per chamber diameter

Each slug caliber requires a different diameter of the magazine chamber in order to function properly. Below you will find all available slug-compatible magazines to fit specific calibers.

Pellet magazine options

Note that the 4.5 mm / .177 and 7,62 mm * .30 caliber magazine is compatible with both pellets and slugs due to similar chamber dimensions. Each package therefore includes two identical magazines.
